



Dr. Prof T.Krishnan

Thriyambakam Krishnan obtained M.Stat and Ph.D. degree from the Indian Statistical Institute (ISI). He then joined the faculty of the Indian Statistical Institute, where he remained until his retirement in 1998 as Professor of Applied Statistics. His work in the Institute had several components: research, teaching, consultancy and administration.

He has been the Dean of Studies and Professor-in-Charge (Chairman) of his Division. He has spent his eight sabbatical years in the University of Southampton, University of Western Australia and other places in Europe, Japan, etc.

Krishnan's research interests are in Statistical Pattern Recognition, Biostatistics, Psychometry and Statistical Computing and has about 40 research publications and a book "The EM Algorithm and Extensions" (John Wiley & Sons, 1997). Krishnan has extensive consultancy experience and has helped and collaborated with scientists of various kind---biologists, medical researchers, economists, other social scientists, engineers, etc.---in statistical analysis relating to their work. He has successfully undertaken projects and consultancy work for government and other organizations like the of the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), Reserve Bank of India (RBI), etc.

At present he is a full-time technical consultant and the Chief Statistical Architect of the statistical software SYSTAT and Head of the Statistical Consultancy and R & D Unit of Cranes Software International Limited, Bangalore.
